## CLAY COUNTY LAND SURVEY INDEX

The Clay County Recorder of Deeds has a new link. This site is a combination of Missouri DNR Land Survey Index and Clay County's recorded plats and surveys that have been microfilmed by Rolla. The site is used much like the Missouri DNR Land Survey Index or "blue" book located in the Recorder of Deeds office. The Recorder of Deeds received the film from Missouri DNR Land Survey Program in digitized format.

To locate the site, please direct your web browser to the Recorder of Deeds website at <http://recorder.claycogov.com>; the films are found under "General Information" and then "Links".

Select "Clay County Land Survey Index".

A map of Clay County will appear, subdivided by townships and ranges. You may click anywhere on the map to see the documents associated with the location.

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In order to access the digitized copies, please click on any of the links in the "Film Loc" column. Please note that the entries on the list are organized in the same manner as the original microfilms. Typically, there will be up to four documents listed under one location, any one of which may contain the document you are interested in.

Note – Clay County's prefix is 047, the items with a 95, 165, 720 or 721 prefix have not been provided to Clay County and therefore the images are not available from our website. To obtain copies of images not provided contact the Missouri DNR Land Survey Program; a link to the DNR is located in the "Links" section of the Clay County Recorder's web site.
